**Guidance to Annex 7:**

The person responsible for PSS must describe the relevant common areas with the one who is responsible for setting up, maintaining, dismantling and for which period, including:

- The Traffic areas, welfare areas and storage areas, work areas, technical aids and supplies.
- The coordination and delimitation of all works in common areas, and description of the selected safety measures.
- How a demarcation is carried out in all areas of work where there are special dangerous work activities.
- How the ongoing control is carried out.
- Coordination of emergency and exercise plans

The location, capacity and weather-resistance of traffic and access roads and scaffolding, (weight class, width, Access roads and location) are key safety issues on site.

For construction site welfare measures the following must be described:

- Sheds for Crew, supervisors, construction management and meetings
- Dressing and bathing sheds
- Toilet facilities
- Location of personal Protective equipment

The description of common measures must be submitted for commenting to the relevant persons etc..

Remember that several contractors may not be responsible for the same common measure during the same period.
